Other requirements

- A trainee is required to write a short report regarding the employer's circumstance, kind of work and working environment. The report must be handed in IAESTE Thailand a week before the internship ends.
- Shorts are prohibited at work (Proper clothes are preferable).
- Arrival on the working days is preferable.
- If there is any question regarding the internship, please directly contact IAESTE Thailand only!

*****Remarks:** Free time –

It is highly recommended that a trainee respect the work schedule of the employer and take his/her free time only on weekends, holidays or those days designated by the employer.

Significant other –

In the past, bringing a significant other person while attending the internship has proven to be unsuccessful. Conflicts in schedules and distractions have in some cases led to a less than productive experience for both intern and employer. It is therefore requested that a trainee arrive unaccompanied to get maximum benefit from the time spent in his/her internship.

**Visa application –

You are required to apply for a visa at your nearest Thai Embassy or Consulate. It is very important to apply as soon as you get you acceptance papers from IAESTE THAILAND the application procedure sometimes takes 8-12 week. **The type of visa that you should get is Non-immigrant-"ED" only.** If you wish to travel the countries nearby Thailand, make sure that you have the multi-entries visa.

We need to be informed about your visa extension at least 2 weeks before its expiration date.
